


# Downloading Zinio Magazines for PCs, Macs, Tablets, and Mobile Devices from the Marion Public Library (iPod Touch/iPhone/iPad, Android phones/tablets, Kindle Fire) (not compatible with Nook)

## Steps 1 – 12 are a one-time setup.

1. Go to the RBDigital portal for the Metro Library Network at: <http://tinyurl.com/mlnzinio>. You may want to bookmark this site for easier access later.


**Tip:** It's easiest to navigate the RBDigital portal on a computer rather than on a tablet or phone.

2. Create an RBDigital account, using your library card number, by clicking on the link in the upper right of the screen.



7. **Click on the cover of any magazine** to see details and **Checkout**. You can also find and check out back issues of many magazines by scrolling to the bottom of the details page.


**Have you created a zinio.com personal reading list account?** If not, you will need to click "Create a Zinio account" in the pop up screen after "Start Reading."

Please be advised that once you click Start Reading, you are leaving your library's RBDigital Gateway site and entering Zinio.com, the commercial site where you can read your checked out magazines. Zinio.com also offers the option to search and subscribe to paid-for magazines not available in your library collection.

- To read on a phone or tablet (except Kindle), **download the Zinio app** from your device's App Store (Google Play store for Android devices).
- If you have a **Kindle**, download the Zinio app directly from: <http://tinyurl.com/ziniokindle>, following the instructions there.
- Once the app is installed, find the settings menu at the top or bottom of your screen, which may be a gear icon, three lines, or three vertical dots, depending on your device.




- Sign in using the Zinio account** you created in step 4 above.



- Once signed in, use the back arrow to get back to the main screen.



- You can **view your magazines by tapping on the book icon** near the top or bottom of the screen (depending on your device). The magazines you checked out on the Zinio website should start syncing to your device in a few minutes, as long as you have a Wi-Fi connection. If it doesn't sync, try closing the Zinio app and re-opening it.



- Tap the cover of each magazine to open it and swipe to turn the page. Zoom in on an article to read it or tap the **Text** icon to remove the images for easier reading.




**Tip:** If you see a screen asking you to purchase magazines through the Zinio app, look for the My Library book icon to get back to the library magazines you downloaded.



16. To check out more Zinio magazines from the library, go back to the RBDigital website:  
<http://tinyurl.com/mlnzinio> on a computer and click on Login in the upper right. Use the RBDigital account you created in step 2.




17. Choose another magazine to check out or click **Start Reading** in the upper right to view the **Reading List** of magazines you have checked out previously.



18. To remove magazines from your Reading List and all your devices, click the list view (circled) and select the magazines you want to delete.



19. To remove magazines just from your device, tap **Edit** near the top of your screen. Tap on the **X** next to each magazine you would like to delete. You can download them again later by tapping **Edit**, then **Restore**, and selecting which magazines to re-download.
