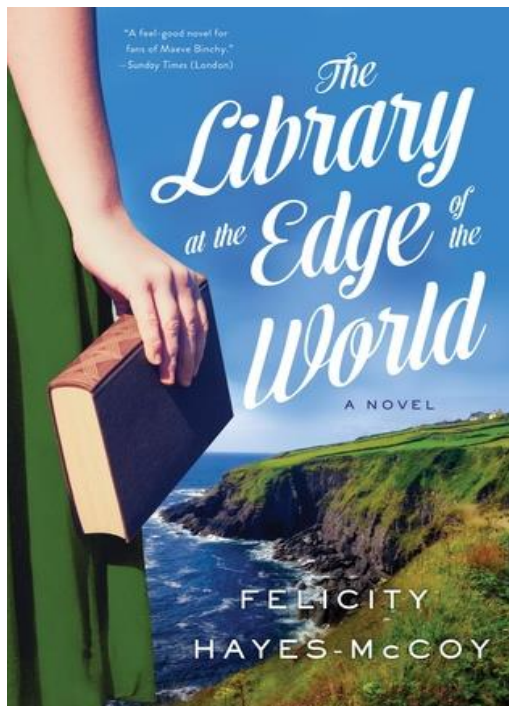


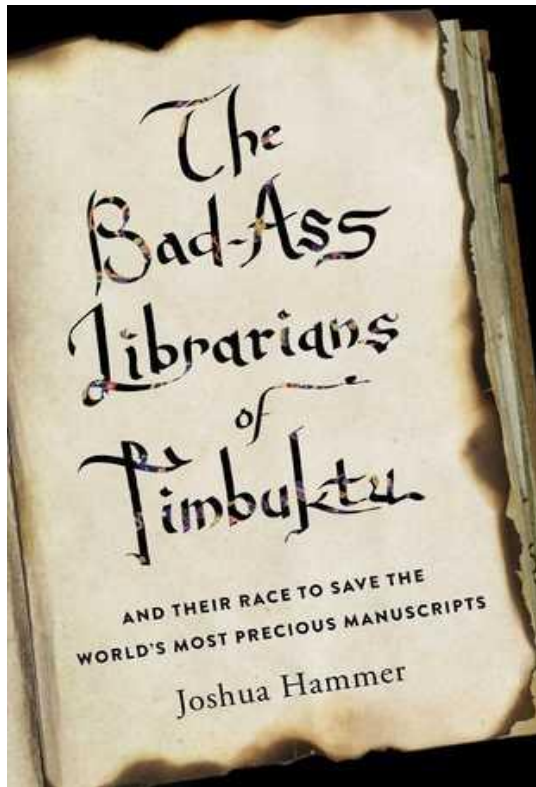
## Books about Libraries and Librarians: Friday Edition
