Provisions

Information for educational, cultural or other not-for-profit groups may be posted on the community bulletin board or in the display racks in the library's lobby. These groups include but are not limited to Marion community organizations and community organizations from surrounding communities.

Items for the community bulletin board must be approved, stamped, and posted by a library staff person. Posting of notices, brochures, and fliers does not imply endorsement of the viewpoints expressed in the items by the library staff, volunteers, or any of the library's advocacy groups.

Postings and pamphlets may be rearranged or removed at the discretion of library staff. Due to demand for community bulletin board space, items will be posted based on space availability.

The library will periodically arrange for and publicize special exhibits and displays that are in keeping with its mission.

The Marion Public Library follows the interpretation of the <u>Library Bill of Rights Relating to Exhibit Spaces and Bulletin</u> Boards.
