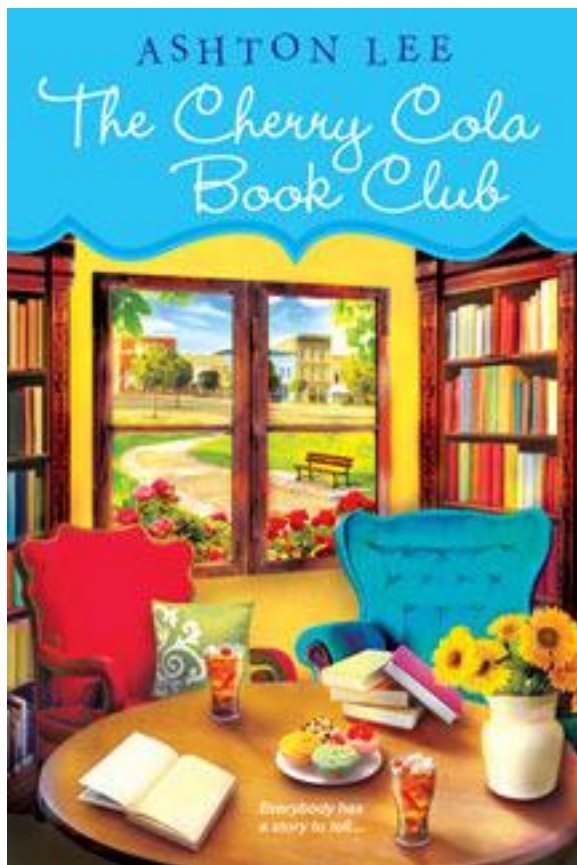


## Books about Libraries and Librarians to Celebrate National Library Week

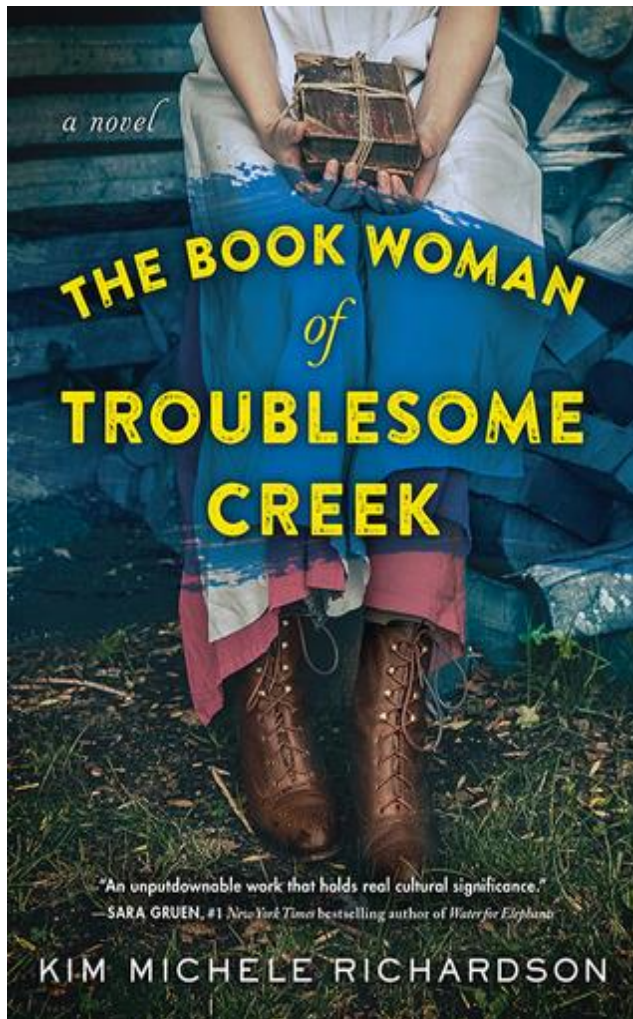
Here's another round of books that celebrate libraries and librarians:

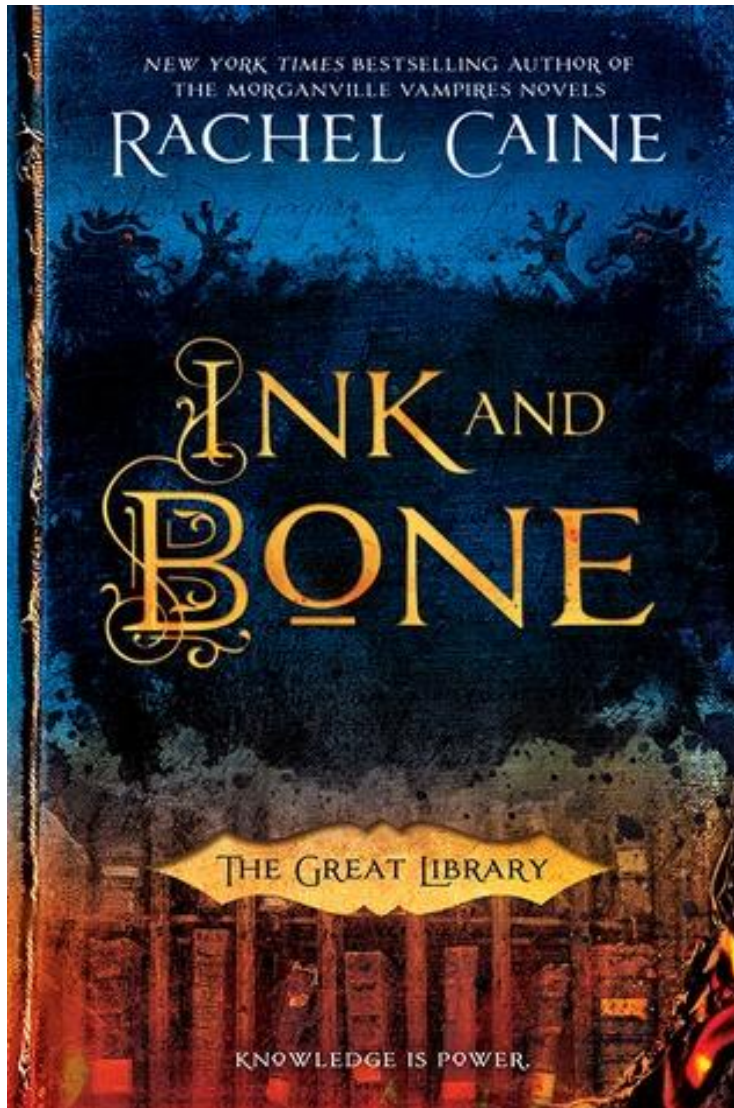
