

## Book-A-Bike Guidelines

- 1. Borrowers must be 18 years of age or older. Patrons under 18 years of age are not permitted to check out or ride the bikes.
- 2. Borrowers must have a current Metro library card in good standing to use equipment; there is a checkout limit of one bike per library card. Patrons with Quick cards and online cards are not eligible to check out bicycles.
- 3. Borrowers must obey traffic and bike path rules and courtesies, as well as follow City of Marion and State of Iowa bike regulations.
- 4. Borrowers may only use bikes within Marion city limits.
- Bikes and equipment may be borrowed for the day they are checked out. Bikes and equipment may not be borrowed overnight or over the weekend.
- 6. All equipment must be returned at least 30 minutes before closing.
- 7. When left unattended, equipment must be locked and secured.
- 8. All borrowers must sign a Lending Agreement and Liability Waiver each time they check out a bicycle.
- 9. There are no fees or fines to use Book-A-Bike. However, if bicycles and equipment are not returned as expected, there is a \$5 per day late fee.
- 10. Equipment not returned will be treated as theft.
- 11. Borrowers must report any damage or malfunctions to library staff immediately.
- 12. Borrowers are responsible for stolen or lost equipment.
- 13. A safety inspection checklist must be completed when equipment is returned.



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
